The chronology of Kurdistan and the history of Kurdistan and the geopolitical issues related to this land have been written by many people and there are countless books and articles about this.

In short, two of the four parts of Greater Kurdistan are located in northern Syria and northern Iraq, and now have different conditions from the parts located in western Iran and eastern Turkey.

After widespread rebellions and the start of the civil war in Syria, the Syrian Kurds took control of the Kurdish areas of northern Syria at the suggestion of Bashar al-Assad, the president of Syria, in order for the Kurds not to enter the civil war and for Syria generally not to be attacked by Turkey.

Today I read news about the interference of Palestinian villagers around Jerusalem who send money to a charity organization in Turkey to create settlements in Afrin in Syrian Kurdistan to accommodate imported Arabs and this method changes the demography of this region. Saddam Hussein did the same thing in Kirkuk (Iraqi Kurdistan) and the governments after Saddam Hussein in Iraq are more or less doing this project.

This is a dirty, totalitarian, and fascist plan and it must stop.

The story of Afrin started with the Turkish army's invasion of this city and its surrounding areas in 2018.

The world knows that the Turkish regime plans to revive the Republic of Hatay.
