Western Wall

Western Wall in Jerusalem, the eternal capital of Israel... This wall is located under the Sirius star. This wall is named after the Izad Enki.

Enki is the guardian of the waters. People mistakenly think that Goddess Haana is the guardian deity of the waters. No! Haana is the guardian deity of the Instant glow of water.

The stone had a special respect among the Mardukhis because according to the beliefs of the Baayi religion, Mardukh was the son of Enki, the manifestation of the brilliance of a stone in water. Yes! The same black stone that is in the center of the pool of life and is on the fountain and rotates due to the flow of water. The shine of this stone, which is caused by water, is the manifestation of the soul of Mardukh.

So the star on the flag of Israel is the symbol of the manifestation of Izad Mardukh. He is the ruler of the fifth planet or Jupiter.

Jupiter is number six in the solar system. Therefore, the six-pointed star on the Israeli flag is the symbol of Mardukh, who is called "Mordechai" in the Hebrew accent of the Bible.

The number six is a sign of two things: Shushtian or the last purified, who is the Mashiakh, and also the ark of the covenant, which belongs to the Akkadians of Kur-Dilmun. They were called Mannayi or Manashi or Tan-Naani. They were also called Ardini and Aashawaani or miller.

Haarat, Faraat, Taarah or Daarah or Daariwa or Ardiwa which means miller, was the father of Prophet Abraham.

Abraham or Abrawan means eyebrow or baru which means Battlement or protection on the wall of the castle.

This is why the family of Abraham was called Ibrani or Hebrews. Four thousand years ago, the Mannaeans were Akkadian pastoralists. Akkad was the ancient

pronunciation of the word Kekhuwa or Dehkhoda. The chiefs of Akkadian villages were called Chokha or Kekhwa or Kwekha.

Abraham's father moved to the important and holy centers of Akkad, namely Kalkhu (Karkuk) and Harran (Rhaa), because there were great temples of the DuDaa or "Manifestation of the Holy Spirit in water".

But Abraham, according to tradition, migrated to Canaan because there was the Wall of Dudaa, where he was to become a priest. The sign of this wall was the number six. It means the number of Mardukh and the millstone and stone of the ancient Sangiputis or Hakkaris.
