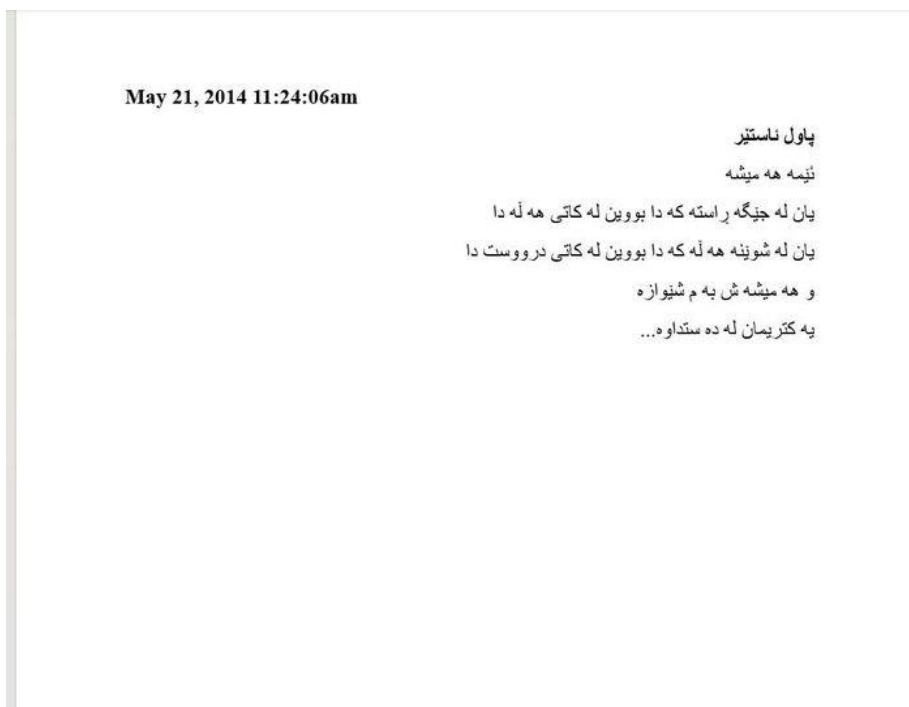


Brief view
