Gulbahar, Badinan and Shupari

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When God created the high and beautiful stature of Kurdistan, He ordered the angels to sew an expensive gown for this worthy body.

They sewed a purple cloak and put it on Kurdistan's shoulders.

Badinan بۆتان, and Botan بۆتان are behind and on this purple cloak.

Mrs. Gulbahar, who passed away a few years ago, is one of the old singers of Kurdish music in Kurmanji dialect. She is from Badinan.

I have always loved her feminine and kind voice since I was a child of seven or eight years old. I used to hear his voice on Kurdish radio in Baghdad.

She sang her last song very nostalgically. I put the link of this clip so that you can watch and listen too.

This naturalistic song rises from the depths of the native feelings of the people of Badian and the middle region of Great Zab and Khabur rivers.

Badinan was one of the cultural and historical centers of ancient Kurdistan since ancient times. One of the tribes that lived there were Shubartis.

Shubarti is the name of this tribe in Sumerian culture.

In the ancient mystical interpretations of the Bayi ritual or the balance scale for justice, Shupari is the shadow, and the interpretation of the shadow in ancient Egyptian symbols is the eyelid.

This eye, which is the center of creation (Kur-Dilmun) or current Saqez, is located in the Ascendant of Libra, symbolized by the scales of justice. And Badinan is the eyelid of this eye. Other names of Shubarti are Shubari, Subari, Zebari.

Shupari means eyelid in the Sumerian language, which is the father of the current Kurdish language.

The element of Chopari, Kopari, Chopari, Kapri or shade is its material organizational embodiment.

Shupari, in the mystical interpretations of the ancient Kurdish Mithraic religion, which is the source of current mysticism in religions related to the El-Khasi religion or naturalism, means the cause of the hangover of the eyes of the first creature (Hwakhshatara) to its creator, the Almighty God.

This factor is the gem of creation, that is, clean water. It means tears.

Therefore, Shupari means beautiful eyes that show in their hangover.

Hwakhshatara was a three-cornered juicy gem. It means Darwesha, Darwish, Shurida, Ushidar, Khoshadara, Zoroaster, Artakhshara, Ardasher, Shiruward, Suraward, Shirwan, Zardasht and its symbol is a rotating triangle or a rotating

cluster grapes and it is the foundation of creation and it consists of pre-eternity, immortality and eternity. Hwakhashatara is the flesh of God's body, which is separated from the right flank(paraasu) of God the Creator.

The flesh of God the Creator is the "flowing brightness" that is like a river. Therefore, Therefore, the essence of Hwakhshatare is the skin of God, which is interpreted as a shadow, and if we interpret the brightness of God's essence as an eye, then its eyelid is the same skin or shadow, and that is parāsu or Shupari.

But why was this holy name chosen for this people in Bahdinan and the banks of the great Zab river?

As I said, the ancestors of the Kurds were the founders of godliness. They were mystics and Sufis. They have likened this bright, big, roaring and permanent river to the source of life, and because they themselves settled in the heights on the left side of it, which is the position of Pre-Eternity or Saturn, they became known as Shupari. It means that the Zab river is the eye and the mountains on the left side are the eyelids of this eye.

Sorry! It's early in the morning and I have to start my daily life and I have a lot to do, so I won't write more.

But it is good to know that Badinan includes the cities of Amedi, Akre, Zakho, Dohuk, Sheladze, Semel, and Shekhan.

I ask God's blessing for the people of Badinan. For the happiness of the soul of the great artist Ms. Gulbahar, I ask God for mercy.

Finally, I must add that I am a normal person and have nothing to do with astrology. Also, I am not familiar with magic and fortune-telling and watching palms. I have no connection with abnormal beings. I have left my enemies in the hands of the God I believe in so that they are in the captivity of his will and
